What not to bring:

- **Candy or chewing gum** (*Bears LOVE sweets!*)
- **Money** (*canteen money will be collected at the time of drop-off from parents*)
- **iPods, or other music players** (*these have a huge risk of growing legs and disappearing!*)
- **Jewelry** (*watches, and earrings that do not hang are okay. You may bring jewelry to wear only for the formal dinner on Friday, but please keep them in a secure case and only wear them on Friday night.*)
- **Electronic games, gaming systems, or computer equipment** (*our days are packed full of excitement and you would have no time to play them anyway. These will be confiscated until your parents pick you up on Saturday.*)
- **Cell Phones** (*these get lost, wet, stolen, and damaged easily, plus you will have no reception anyway to use them! Calling home only intensifies feelings of homesickness. Cell phones will be confiscated until the end of the week if found and given to parents when the campers are picked up.*)
