Refund Policy

A full refund will be made if the camp session would be cancelled, if an emergency situation arises for an individual and the Council is notified prior to the start of camp, or if the registration is cancelled 2 or more weeks prior to the start of the session. A partial refund will be made to campers who are unable to complete a camp session due to illness or emergency. No refund will be made if the participant does not show and has not contacted the office.

To secure your child's spot you must submit a \$25 deposit for day camp, or a \$50 deposit for overnight resident camp. The full payment amount for resident camp is due no later than 1 week prior to the start of your child's camp session.
